The Provincial used to be the Natwest bank. It is next to the Captain Scott pub, opposite the History and Arts centre on Bute Street, Cardiff Bay.

By Bus -

The Baycar 6 runs regularly from Cardiff City Centre to Cardiff Bay. For more bus travel information contact **Traveline** on **0871 200 2233** or visit **transportdirect.info**

By Train-

Trains run regularly from Cardiff Central to Cardiff Bay. For further information contact **National Rail** on **08457 484950**.

By Car –

From the West (Swansea, Carmarthenshire)

Leave the M4 at junction 33. Join the A4232 and continue for about 9.3 miles. Leave the A4232 just before the Butetown Tunnel, sign posted Techniquet. At the round about take the exit onto Stuart St E. Continue on to Bute Street.

From the East (Newport, Bristol, Midlands)

Leave the M4 at junction 29. and join A48 M. Stay on this road until the exit marked Docks. Follow road markings for city centre. As you approach city centre turn left onto Eastern Avenue. Continue to follow A4161. At the round about, take the second exit onto Newport Rd. Turn left at Bresford Rd. Continue on to East Tyndall street. Go through two roundabouts and continue onto Herbert Street. Turn left at Bute Street.

Parking -

There is limited parking at the rear of the building. Mermaid Quay car park is just a short walk away and is open 24hrs.

Refreshments -

Water will be available at the venue but there is no bar on site. The Captain Scott pub is next door to The Provincial and the Eli Jenkins is situated a short walk away, on Bute Crescent.

Mewn Car –

O'r Gorllewin (Abertawe, Sir Gaerfyrddin)  
Gadewch yr M4 ar gyffordd 33. Ymunwch â'r A4232 ac ymlaen â chi am ryw 9.3 milltir. Gadewch yr A4232 yn union cyn Twnel Butetown, gan ddilyn yr arwydd am Techniquet. Gadewch y gylchfan gan ddilyn arwydd Stuart St E. Ymlaen â chi at Stryd Bute.

O'r Dwyrain (Casnewydd, Bryste, Canolbarth Lloegr)

Gadewch yr M4 ar gyffordd 29 ac ymunwch â'r A48 M. Ymlaen â chi hyd nes y gwelwch yr arwydd am y Dociau. Dilynwch yr arwyddion tuag at ganol y ddinas. Wrth i chi nesáu at ganol y ddinas trowch i'r chwith ar hyd Rhodfa'r Dwyrain/Eastern Avenue. Ymlaen â chi ar yr A4161. Dilynwch yr ail ffordd oddi ar y gylchfan ar hyd Heol Casnewydd. Trowch i'r chwith ar Ffordd Bresford. Ymlaen â chi ar hyd Stryd East Tyndall. Ewch yn syth yn eich blaen drwy ddwy gylchfan ac ymlaen at Stryd Herbert. Trowch i'r chwith ar Stryd Bute.

Parcio -

Mae nifer cyfyngedig o lefydd parcio wrth gefn yr adeilad. Gellir cerdded o faes parcio Cei'r Fôr-forwyn/Mermaid Quay mewn byr o amser ac mae ar agor am 24 awr.

Lluniaeth -

Bydd dŵr ar gael ond nid oes bar yn y lleoliad. Mae tafarn y Captain Scott drws nesaf i'r Provincial ac mae'r Eli Jenkins o fewn tafliad carreg ar Gilgant Bute.
